THE SELBORNE SOCIETY

The Selborne Society owns and manages Perivale Wood Local Nature Reserve. The 27 acres of mixed oak woodland, meadows and ancient pasture, with streams & ponds, abound with interest - birds, small mammals, insects, plants and aquatic life. The Reserve offers excellent opportunities for observation, conservation and education.

A nature reserve is not just land that is left alone - it would rapidly deteriorate without careful and sympathetic management. Without altering the character and use of the land, hedges must be laid, ditches cleared, and clearings maintained.

Trees also need attention, with occasional felling to allow the development of new standard oak, ash etc., also coppicing of hazel to encourage the growth of traditional woodland plants.

There are many opportunities for members to become involved in the conservation and management of the Reserve.

The Society holds regular monthly meetings at the Reserve - one for adult members & one for juniors - concentrating on a particular aspect each time; also, members can enter the Reserve at other times.

Additionally, there is a programme of indoor meetings throughout the winter, and occasional outings to places of special interest during the year.

Parties from local schools and other organisations may visit the Reserve by prior arrangement. There is a signposted nature trail, and it is normally possible for a warden to accompany them
